MINUTES – COUNCIL MEETING – MONDAY, NOVEMBER 30, 2020 – 6:00 P.M.
LOCATION: ALAMO COMMUNITY CENTER

IN ATTENDANCE: Mayor Pamela Lee, Bobby Cox, Dondrea Geter, Steve Jones, Harry Lewis, and Thomas Lott.

Meeting called to order at 6:03 pm by Mayor Pamela Lee.

- 1. Invocation – Jeff Floyd**
- 2. Approve Agenda – Geter** made the motion to approve but add Old Rec. Dept funding, **Cox 2nd**, unanimously approved.

OLD BUSINESS

- 3. Adopt Budget & Ordinance – Cox** made the motion to adopt 2021 budget and ordinance, **Geter 2nd**, unanimously approved.
- 4. Adopt Resolution for sale of land to BOE – Woodard** made the motion to approve the resolution, **Lewis 2nd, Geter & Lott approved. Cox and Jones opposed.**
- 5. Code Enforcement Officer discussion – CM Floyd** was just wanted to refresh the council on the code enforcement officer. Started out the end of last year, when Shane McCullar was hired to do the job, but never got back in touch with the city. Floyd got with Alan Scarborough from Dublin and agreed to do the job. Members of council addressed that some of them received a call from a citizen and did not know anything about it when the Code Officer was on their property. Floyd stated that we will look on getting the officer in a marked vehicle and send out notification before.
- 6. Rec. Dept Fund – Cox** made the motion to take the \$44,300, what it is going to cost for the basketball court & fence, out of the Savings account, **Lott 2nd**, unanimously approved.
- 7. Adopt Millage Rate & Ordinance (30 min later)–** milage rate will be set at 8.498, which is a no change from previous year. **Jones** made the motion, **Lewis 2nd**, unanimously approved.

Meeting adjourned at 6:40 PM with Lewis making the motion, Lott 2nd, unanimously approved.
