#### **ORDINANCE**

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR APPROVAL OF THE MILLAGE RATE FOR LEVY OF AD VALOREM TAXES FOR TAX YEAR 2020 AND REPEALING ALL OTHER ORDINANCES AND SECTIONS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH:

It is ordained by the Mayor and Council of the City of Alamo, Georgia as follows:

Whereas, the 2021 budget was presented for final approval at a city council meeting on November 30, 2020 and was duly approved; and

Whereas, notice of the date for consideration of the millage rate for 2020 taxes was published in the The Advance on November 18, 2020 and on November 25, 2020 and said notice contained the information required by law, all as provided in O.C.G.A. Section 48-5-32(b)(1)(B), 48-5-32(b)(2) and 48-5-32(c)(1); and

Whereas, the millage rate for 2020 ad valorem taxes was presented for final approval at a city council meeting on November 30, 2020, and after discussion the millage rate of 8.498 mills was approved by vote of the city council; therefore, the millage rate is approved and adopted as follows:

SECTION I. <u>MILLAGE RATE</u>. The millage rate for levy of ad valorem taxes for the year 2020 is fixed at 8.498 mills, and the millage rate as fixed is hereby approved and adopted as required by Section 6.02 of the Charter for the City of Alamo.

SECTION II. <u>DUE DATE</u>. The due date for payment of ad valorem taxes for the year 2020 shall be <u>Novel</u>, 2021 after which the unpaid taxes shall be delinquent and subject to penalties and interest as provided by law. Taxes may be paid prior to the due date and must be paid in one lump sum. No provision is made for partial payments or installment payments of taxes.

Section III. <u>NO INCREASE</u>. The millage rate does not result in an increase from the previous tax year and does not exceed the roll back rate.

SECTION IV. <u>SUFFICIENT REVENUE PROJECTED</u>. The millage rate as approved and adopted will provide sufficient revenue which, together with other anticipated revenues, fund balances and applicable reserves, will equal the total amount appropriated for each of the several funds set forth in the annual operating budget for fiscal year 2021.

### SECTION V. REPEAL.

This ordinance shall be cumulative of all other ordinances which may govern the subject matter hereof except to the extent that such ordinances or parts of ordinances are in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance. To the extent of any such conflict, such prior ordinances or parts thereof in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

# SECTION VI. SEVERABILITY.

In the event any section, provision or portion of this ordinance shall be declared unconstitutional or unenforceable in whole or in part, such invalidity shall not have the effect of destroying or impairing the validity of the remaining parts of this ordinance, and the remaining portion shall remain in full force and effect.

# SECTION VII. EFFECTIVE DATE.

#### ORDINANCE

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR ADOPTION OF THE 2021 BUDGET AND REPEALING ALL OTHER ORDINANCES AND SECTIONS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH:

It is ordained by the Mayor and Council of the City of Alamo, Georgia as follows:

Whereas, the proposed budget for fiscal year 2021 was presented to the city council for initial consideration at a meeting on October 19,2020, and a copy of the budget was made available to the public as required by law; and

Whereas, notice of the availability of the budget was published in the Wheeler County Eagle on October 21, 2020, 2020; and

Whereas, notice of a public meeting to be held for the purpose of allowing the public to be heard concerning the budget was published in the Wheeler County Eagle on November 11, 2017, and the public hearing was held on November 16, 2020 as set forth in the notice; and

Whereas, notice of the date for final approval of the 2021 budget and for consideration of the millage rate for 2018 was published in the Wheeler County Eagle on November 18, 2020 and on November 25, 2020; and

Whereas, the 2021 budget was presented for final approval at a city council meeting on November 30, 2020, and after discussion the budget was approved by vote of the city council; therefore the budget is approved and adopted as follows:

SECTION I. The budget in the form attached to this ordinance is approved and adopted as the budget for the City of Alamo for the fiscal year 2021.

SECTION II. The fiscal year for the budget and for financial accounting purposes shall be the calendar year beginning January 1 and ending December 31.

SECTION III. The budget as approved and adopted will provide a revenue surplus for the budget year (after deducting depreciation from total expenses to reflect actual cash outlays).

SECTION IV. Expenditures during the fiscal year from any of the several funds provided by the budget shall not exceed the appropriations for such fund without prior amendment of the budget by city council.

### SECTION V. REPEAL.

This ordinance shall be cumulative of all other ordinances which may govern the subject matter hereof except to the extent that such ordinances or parts of ordinances are in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance. To the extent of any such conflict, such prior ordinances or parts thereof in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

# SECTION VI. SEVERABILITY.

In the event any section, provision or portion of this ordinance shall be declared unconstitutional or unenforceable in whole or in part, such invalidity shall not have the effect of destroying or impairing the validity of the remaining parts of this ordinance, and the remaining portion shall remain in full force and effect.

# SECTION VII. EFFECTIVE DATE.

This ordinance shall take effect from and after the 30 day of November, 2020.
